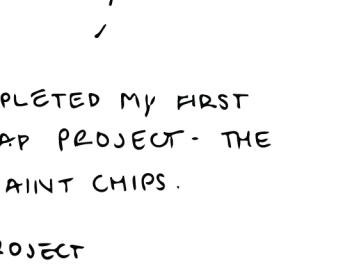

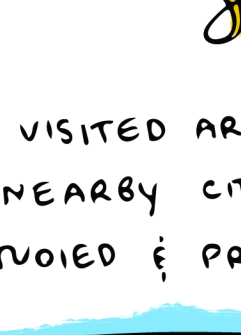

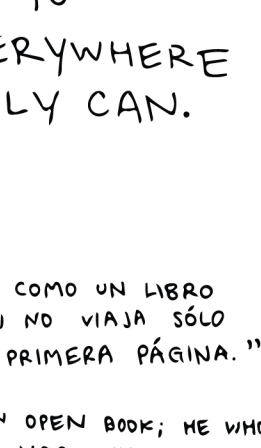
AFTER THAT DISCOVERY, I FINISHED BOTH SEMESTERS ON THE dean's list. **A+**

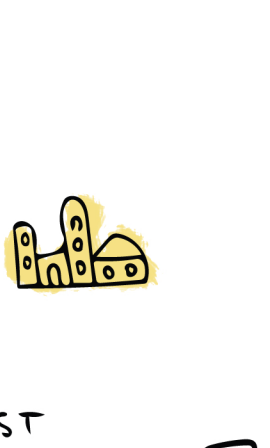

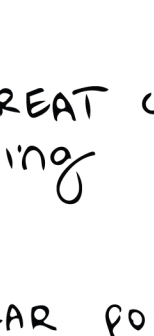

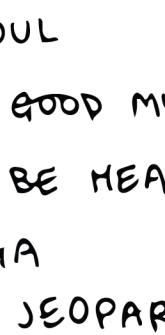
